RULES 2019

1.1 CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION & TOURNAMENT

« Open de France » is a cash price slalom tournament with 2 preliminaries round and a night final.

Each skier (French or foreign) with a licence and the following minima can participate:

Femmes	Hommes
3/55/16,00m	3/58/14,25m

The tournament will take place as following:

- ✓ Preliminary round 1
- ✓ Preliminary round 2
- ✓ Night Final

1.2 PRELIMINARY ROUND 1 AND 2

✓ **Preliminary round 1** will be held during the preliminary round of the French Nationals.

All skiers (French National and Open de France) will be mixed in series depending the ranking list results.

✓ **Preliminary round 2** will be held during the final A & B of the French National.

The order of the skiers for preliminary round 2 will be the reverse of their scores in the round 1 but will be shared in 2 groups.

- 1- Skiers participating only to the "Open de France" tournament will be automatically put in "final B" group.
- 2- Skiers participating at both French National and Open de France will be either in final A or B group depending of their results and number of skier in French National final.

1.3 NIGHT FINAL

8 Skiers men and women can be qualified in final as long as minimum 4 French skiers are in final.

Whatever their rank after preliminaries rounds, the first 4 French skiers will be automatically qualified in final. The 4 remaining places will be taken from the best standing from preliminaries rounds.

The order of the skiers qualified for the final round will be the reverse of their scores in the preliminaries rounds.

The night final will start at night, around 9pm, therefore this final cannot be homologated in view of the expected lighting.

1.4 CASH PRICE

In case of a tie for the first place, there will be a runoff. In case of tie for other place, scores of the preliminaries round will be taken.



1.5 LIGHTS & SECURITY

Each buoys will be lighted with inside LED.

Small platforms placed at the opposite of each buoys and 2 lights on the shore, as shown in the figure below, will allow to illuminate the slalom course. 2 platforms will also be placed at each end of the lake in order to illuminate the turn. For security, the boat and the skiers will be equipped by small light.

It will be asked to skiers to stay behind the boat during the turn and when their passes are done. If a skier fall during his pass, it will be asked to not move in the water in order to be seen by the boat and be safely recovered.



1.6 PROTESTS

No protest will be accepted for :

- ✓ Buoys not enough light
- ✓ Disturbing lights
- ✓ Reduced visibility
